

2018 Chuck Baird Memorial Art Competition

The National American Sign Language Honor Society (ASLHS) is pleased to announce the Fall 2018 Chuck Baird Memorial Art Competition. The following instructions and forms provide the necessary information to participate in the competition. To participate, students must attend a school with a current ASLHS chapter on campus.

There are two categories –

Reproduction: Portrait Painting or Drawing

- The artwork shall be a PORTRAIT reproduction of a Deaf person and by a Deaf artist.
- A source of the original artwork being reproduced must be included to be used as a comparison. (This can be a website reference or a print off of the artwork)
- The artwork can be created in the following mediums: watercolor, colored pencils, charcoal, acrylic, oil, and pencil sketch.
- The artwork must be entirely of the student's own creation. Clipart or images taken from the internet are not acceptable.

Original Creation: Portrait Painting or Drawing

- The portrait artwork shall be of a well-known Deaf person.
- The artwork can be created in the following mediums: watercolor, colored pencils, crayons, markers, charcoal, acrylic oil, and pencil sketch.
- The artwork must be entirely of the student's own creation. Clipart or images taken from the internet are not acceptable

Entry deadline: November 9, 2018

For the Teacher:

1. Membership

For your students to participate in this competition, you or another ASL teacher at your school must belong to the National American Sign Language Honor Society (ASLHS) and sponsor an ASLHS chapter on campus. Dues for the 2018-2019 academic year must be current for your students to compete.

If no ASLHS chapter exists on your campus, submit application forms and dues with the 2018 Chuck Baird Memorial Art Competition entries.

Competition entries submitted by students not represented by an official ALHS chapter are automatically disqualified.

If you are including ASLHS membership along with entries into the 2018 Chuck Baird Memorial Art Competition, you must do the following:

1. Include ASLHS & ASLTA membership forms;
2. Include a separate check for ASLHS & ASLTA membership dues

2. Due Date

All entries are due or postmarked by **November 9, 2018**. Late entries will be disqualified.

3. Competition Categories

Students may submit entries in these categories:

Reproduction

- The artwork shall be a PORTRAIT reproduction of a Deaf person and by a Deaf artist.
- A source of the original artwork being reproduced must be included to be used as a comparison. (This can be a website reference or print off of the artwork)
- The artwork can be created in the following mediums: watercolor, colored pencils, charcoal, acrylic, oil, and pencil sketch.
- The artwork must be entirely of the student's own creation. Clipart or images taken from the internet are not acceptable.

Original Composition

- The portrait artwork shall be of a well-known Deaf person.
- The art work can be created in the following mediums: watercolor, colored pencils, crayons, markers, charcoal, acrylic oil, and pencil sketch.
- The artwork must be entirely of the student's own creation. Clipart or images taken from the internet are not acceptable

Students at any level of ASL instruction are welcome to submit entries in one or both categories. There is no differentiation between current levels of ASL.

4. Judging Criteria

All entries will be judged according to the following criteria:

Reproduction

- Likeness of the original portrait artwork by a Deaf artist depicting a Deaf person.
- Quality of artistic composition and overall design based on the reproduction.
 - Technique - The student chooses and utilizes media and tools competently to enhance the appearance of the work.
 - Organization - The use of elements and the principles of art, effectively selecting those which enhance the overall appearance of the work.
 - Integration - The work combines technique, expression and organization through artistic and critical judgment to achieve an effective interpretation or result.
- Overall impression of the art.

Original Creation

- Interpretation and the clarity of art reflecting a portrait of a well-known Deaf person.
- Quality of artistic composition and overall design based on the theme.
 - Technique - The student chooses and utilizes media and tools competently to enhance the appearance of the work.
 - Organization - The use of elements and the principles of art, effectively selecting those which enhance the overall appearance of the work.
 - Integration - The work combines technique, expression and organization through artistic and critical judgment to achieve an effective interpretation or result.
- Overall impression of the art.

5. Registration Fees

Each school submitting an entry must pay the registration fee. The fees are \$25.00 per school, regardless of the number of entries submitted.

6. Payment

Payment for entries must be in check form, made payable to *American Sign Language Honor Society or ASLHS*. **Purchase orders or credit cards are not acceptable.** You may collect the entry fees from your students and send in one check with the full amount, or have students (or a parent / guardian) write a personal check and attach it to the entry form. Entry fees are non-refundable under any circumstances.

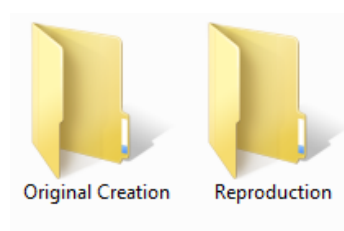

NOTE: In the event a check is returned due to insufficient funds, the ASL Honor Society will turn over the debt to a personal debt collection agency in addition to placing the chapter on probation. If a chapter is on probation, then students are not allowed to participate in ASLHS-sponsored events (including literature competitions and the ASL scholarship), teachers cannot apply for mini-grants, and graduation materials will not be delivered. In addition, any bank fees incurred due to a bounced check will be added to the total amount due.

7. Submission Format (Electronic or Mailed)

Email entries should be sent to competitions.aslhs.com. Please DO NOT send individual student entries in separate emails. Group the entries together by category and send folders of the entries, along with scanned copies of all the paperwork. Google share of files is also an acceptable form of submission.

For mailed entries, only one USB drive per school should be submitted. All entries are to be scanned and submitted as a .jpg or .pdf file on a standard USB drive. On the USB drive, please include a folder for each category (Original Creation and Reproduction).



Entries should be placed within the appropriate folder. Make sure the file name looks like this:

Last name, First name - school acronym – Title of Work

Examples: Scott, Monica – THS – The Periodic Table of Deaf Culture
Travers, Jeff – MU – License Plates

8. Registration Forms

The ASL teacher is responsible for coordinating the completion of all registration forms. There are 4 forms that need to be filled out:

1. Competition cover sheet, filled out by the teacher (Print and include a hard copy or email);
2. School Entry Form, electronic copy filled out by the teacher (Included on the USB drive or email);
3. Payment form, filled out by the teacher (Print and include a hard copy); **mailed to ASLTA Treasurer, PO Box 64801 Rochester, NY 14624**
4. Student Entry form, filled out by the student (Print and include a hard copy or email).

These forms are included in this document.

9. Prizes & Certificates

- All students will receive a certificate of participation. Entries whose works are considered as a Finalist will receive a GOLD seal. Entries whose works are considered in the top will receive a SILVER seal.
- Classroom will receive a certificate of participation
- Monetary prizes, for both categories, are as follows:
 - First place: \$100.00
 - Second place: \$75.00
 - Third place: \$50.00
- Winning students will receive an ASL art magnet from prize from Deaf artist Sheri Youens-un. Teachers with winning students will also receive a prize from Deaf artist Charles Wildbank.

10. Announcement of Winners

Winners will be announced **December 10, 2018**, on the ASL Honor Society website. If your student wins in any category, you will be informed prior to the announcement.

11. Winning Entries

Winning entries will be posted on the ASL Honor Society's webpage. **It is essential that any student under 18 years of age have a parent or guardian's permission to have their child's entry posted.** This information appears on the student's entry form.

12. Return of USB Drives

All submissions become the property of ASLHS and will not be returned, so please make a backup copy of all entries. USB drives can be returned if you include return postage.
