



2024 ASLHS Chuck Baird Art Competition Category: De'VIA Inspired Art Student Packet

The Official Rules

- To participate, students must attend a school with a current ASLHS chapter on campus.
- The entry shall have elements of De'VIA genre.
- The entry must be entirely of the student's own creation. Clipart or images taken from the internet are not acceptable.
- All art pieces must be the original work of the student and cannot be derived from any pre-existing or third-party designs, trademarks, or copyrighted images.
- The art can be created in the following categories: digital, black and white, collage, watercolor, pencil, sketch, painting, sculpture, and 3D printing. If you want to use a different medium not listed above you need to secure permission from the competition coordinator by sending an email to aslhs.competitions2@aslta.org.
- All entries will become the property of the American Sign Language Honor Society. By submitting an entry, each student agrees all intellectual property rights in the art piece are forfeited and deemed the sole property of the American Sign Language Honor Society.
- The decisions of the Selection Committee will be final.
- Entries must be submitted to <u>Kaleidoscope</u> by November 8th, 2024, 11:59pm EST.

1. Membership

For a student to participate in this competition, one ASL teacher at your school must belong to **BOTH** the American Sign Language Teachers Association (ASLTA) and the American Sign Language Honor Society (ASLHS) and sponsor an ASLHS chapter on campus. You do not have to be that teacher's student to qualify to participate in the competition.

2. Due Date

All entries are due by November 8th, 2024.

3. Submission Format

Entries should be submitted by each student individually via Kaleidoscope.

4. Prizes & Certificates

Certificates will be sent electronically to the teachers to be distributed to the students. All schools and students will receive a certificate of participation.

- Entries whose works are considered as a finalist will receive a seal with their respective place.
- Entries whose works are considered in the top 10% will receive a SILVER seal.
- Monetary prizes are as follows:
 - First place: \$100.00
 - Second place: \$75.00
 - Third place: \$50.00

5. Winning Entries

Winning entries will be posted on the ASL Honor Society's website by mid-December. It is essential that any student under 18 years of age have a parent or guardian's permission to have their child's entry posted. This information appears on the student's entry form.
